



Distance: 3 yards

Rounds Fired: 40

Start Position: Concealed

String 1: No PAR

String 2: 10 Sec PAR

String 3: 8 sec PAR

String 4: 6 sec PAR

Course of Fire: The drill consists of 4 separate strings of fire. Each string of fire consists of engaging 4 targets in order from 1 to 4. Each target is engaged with the number of rounds that corresponds with the number on the target. For example, string 1 would consist of engaging a target labeled “1” with 1 round, a target labeled “2” with 2 rounds, a target labeled “3” with 3 rounds, and a target labeled “4” with 4 rounds with no PAR time. Strings 2, 3, and 4 are the same, but with reducing PAR times. Each target can only be engaged once during the drill. Each miss, or each round shot out of sequence, is a 1 second penalty added to the total time.

Easy: Start from ready position.

Hard: Load each magazine with 5 rounds only.

Legendary: Reduce each PAR by 2 seconds and load each magazine with 5 rounds only.
